BKM FP is a white, mineral dry mortar according to DIN EN 998-1 made of mineral binders and aggregates. BKM FP is low in chromate.

Areas of application

BKM FP is used for thin-layer recoating of masonry and mineral plaster, especially BKM SP, to achieve a fine-grained surface structure (grain size up to 0.4 mm).

Product application

Clean the substrate from dust and loose particles and pre-wet with a brush. Do not apply at temperatures below $+5^{\circ}$ C, when frost is expected or on frozen substrates.

Mix BKM FP with clean water until lump-free. Water requirement approx. 10 litres per 25 kg bag. Brush on and structure or adapt to the existing plaster structure or apply with a trowel and finefelt with a sponge disc. Apply mixed fine filler within one hour. Keep surfaces damp during the hardening phase in warm and dry weather (hang with damp cloths, carefully re-wet). BKM FP can be recoated with restoration plaster paint or lime paint after approx. 2 weeks.
